"The Chinese market remains the fastest growing among the pharmerging markets. In 2009, the total audited pharmaceutical market grew by 27.9 percent to reach \$31.7 billion. China is poised to become the world's third-largest pharmaceutical market next year and will contribute an additional \$40+ billion in annual sales by 2013, comparable to the level of increased sales forecast for the U.S. market in the same period.

At the risk of his own life, he undertook independent investigations and approached the highest levels of leadership with the evidence, where he was then abducted and subjected to torture himself.
